 - Material alterations have been made to the hull or superstructures such as would necessitate the assignment of an increased (c) freeboard.
 - The fittings and appliances for the protection of the openings, guardrails, freeing ports, or the means of access to the crew's quarters have not been in as effective a condition as they were when the Certificate was issued.
 - The structural strength of the ship is lowered to such an extent that the ship is unsafe.
- 6. When this certificate has expired or been canceled, it must be delivered to the Assigning Authority.
